

Building Retreat Distance for Optical Cables



Overview

DIN EN 50174-1:2020-10 (chapter 4. 3) both require that cables that do not meet the fire protection regulations or the requirements of Euroclass Eca may be routed freely within a building for a maximum of 2 m. FIBER OPTIC CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

Fiber optic cable sequential numbers are required at each pole location and vault wall. Sequential numbers will identify conduit length, and slack left in vaults and at poles.

Optical Fiber Cable Installation Guideline

An appropriate termination of the cable is especially required for cables installed in outdoor situations, e.g. down the side of a building and in direct exposure to sunlight.
