Cable bracing works in tension, so it requires two opposing brace assemblies at each brace location. However, use of rigid bracing is limited depending on the drop length. In addition, the owner of the facility imposed additional design criteria for the seismic bracing. Use 2 EZ BN 3/8 to attach cables to FAS PCH for sway bracing.
