

Can the gateway still be used after the fiber optic cable is unplugged



Overview

It will work fine and in many cases you will get the same IP address back unless you leave the modem/router off for many hours. Unless you have a UPS that happens anytime you get a power outage. If unplugging and removing the ONT, remember that the optical pigtail cable and green fibre jack plug is rather fragile, and needs to be kept free from dust: you definitely don't want it just hanging on a skirting board.
