

Configuring a switch for an optical ring network



Overview

When configuring P-Ring, through the web manager or CLI, simply check “Enable P-Ring”, Then, select the ring ports and specify whether the switch performs as the “root” (“Manager”) or “ Client”. That's it! You can now install a safe, loop free ring network. A fiber optic ring network is a physical or logical network topology where devices (usually switches) are connected in a closed-loop using fiber optic cables. Each node is connected to two other nodes, forming a ring-like structure. If one.
