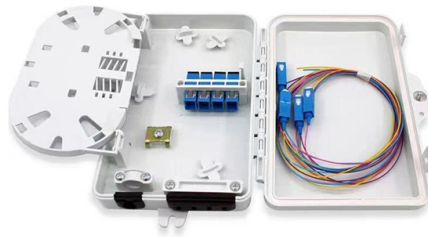


Eastern European Control

The Soviet takeover of Eastern Europe occurred between 1943 and 1948, following a series of strategic actions rooted in the Soviet leadership's desire to establish a buffer zone against potential invasions and ensure economic recovery after World War II. The Eastern Bloc, also known as the Communist Bloc (Combloc), the Soviet Bloc, the Socialist Bloc and the Workers Bloc, was an unofficial coalition of Communist states of Central and Eastern Europe, Asia, Africa, and Latin America that were aligned with the Soviet Union and existed during the Cold.
