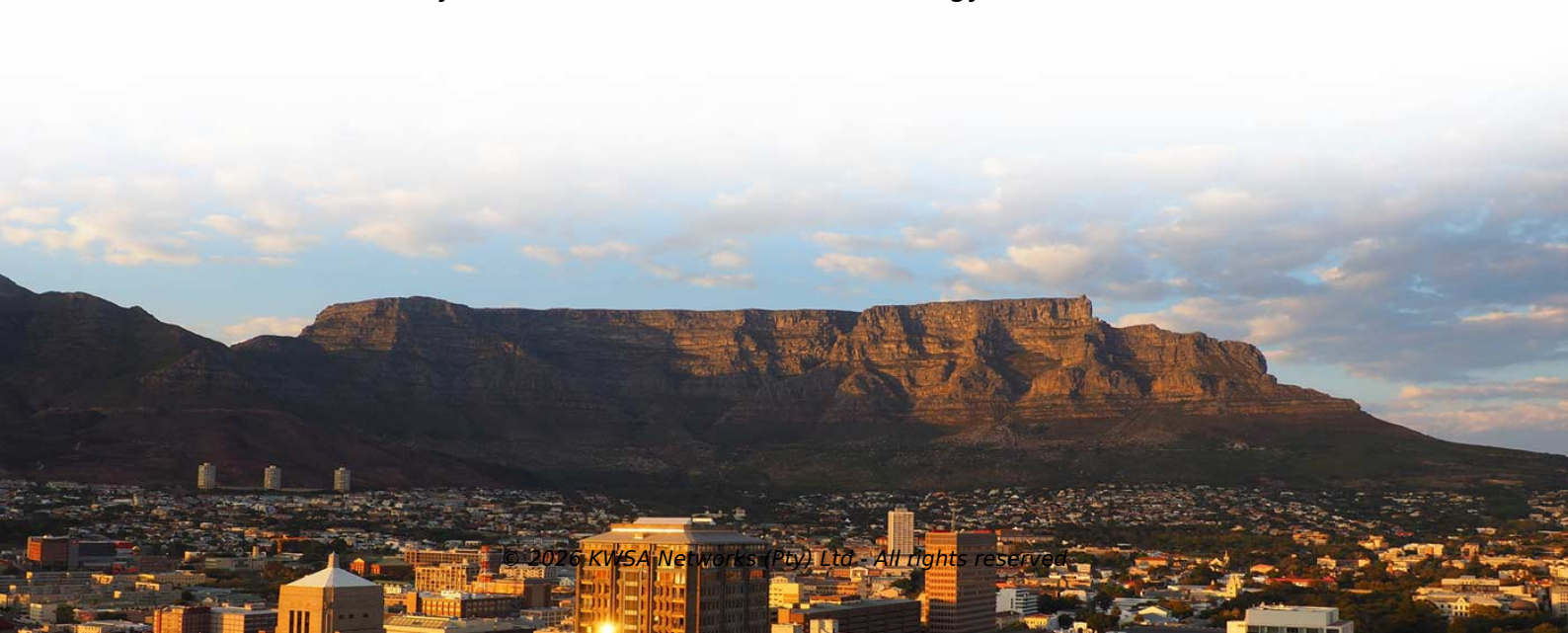


Fiber Optic OM4 Color

Both laser-optimized OM3 and OM4 cable is aqua, as TIA and ISO did not introduce a new color for OM4. OM2 is 50 micron fiber, which provides a much better modal bandwidth than OM1, 500 MHz. However, there are some early OM2 cable installed that is orange, so always check the markings to make sure.
