Overview

In optical fiber systems, crosstalk (also known as optical coupling) occurs when light from one fiber leaks into another fiber, resulting in interference that can degrade the signal quality. This is especially problematic in systems where multiple fibers are bundled together, such as fiber-optic. This page explains the concept of crosstalk in fiber optic networks.
