The terminal box is a fiber management product used to distribute and protect optical fiber links in FTTH networks. The number of ports of fiber optic junction boxes ranges from 8. NEC requires junction boxes to meet size (box fill), material, accessibility, and grounding rules (per Articles 314 & 300). Non-compliance risks safety or code violations. Junction boxes may be small, but they're critical for electrical safety. They also feature resistance to moisture, impact, chemical exposure.
