

How to ground a network cabinet switch



Overview

If yes, how it is/can be achieved?

Most of the low-cost switches I have seen, like say this one or this one. The switch chassis is automatically grounded when you install the switch properly in a grounded rack with metal-to-metal connections between the switch and rack. Alternatively, you can ground the chassis (this is required if the rack is not grounded) by attaching a customer-supplied grounding cable. The shipping box contains the model of the switch you ordered and other components needed for installation. Some components are optional, depending on your order. You will. Before you unpack the switch and before you handle any switch components, be sure that you are wearing a grounded electrostatic discharge (ESD) strap. To ground the strap, attach it directly to an

Verify that the ground wire is securely attached to the grounding lug by attempting to pull the wire out of the crimped lug. Secure the grounding lug to the chassis grounding pad with two M4 screws, and
