

How to make a loop at one end of a communication optical cable



Overview

A mechanically superior and standardized method for forming a permanent loop, especially in cable or high-strength wire, involves using ferrules or crimp sleeves. These are metal tubes placed over the overlapping wire ends to form the loop. If the wire rope isn't coated, use a Flemish splice. Unwind half the strands from the rope to form a Y shape and cross the legs over and rewrap the strands against each other. Service loops are excess cable (slack) that is designed to be in addition to any cable needed for the actual planned drop (run) length and terminations. A common misnomer is. For high-load applications, the Haywire Twist is a robust technique that involves twisting the tag end and the standing wire around each other simultaneously. Bending of a fiber optic cable can damage the cable if the radius of the bend is too small.
