A Fiber Optic Termination Box is a small enclosure located at the terminal end of the fiber where it enters your customer premises. A typical PON topology (GPON, XGS-PON, or 25G PON) flows OLT → fiber distribution hub → passive splitters → distribution/drop fibers → premises. The terminal box sits at the end of the horizontal optical cable. The optical fiber terminal box is usually placed at the end of the horizontal optical cable. For example, the main distribution frame (MDF) located at a telephone central office terminates the cables leading to subscribers on the one hand, and cables. In broadband optical fiber access network, we often see the all kinds of fiber box such as fiber cabinet, fiber optic distribution box, fiber optic terminal box, multimedia box, and customer box.
