A Photomultiplier Tube (PMT) is a photon detector, that outputs a current signal when a photon is detected. The current is converted into a voltage signal by a transimpedance amplifier. In electronics, a transimpedance amplifier (TIA) is a current to voltage converter, almost exclusively implemented with one or more operational amplifiers (opamps). Applications such as PET, SPECT, flow cytometry, LIDAR, fluorescence detection, confocal microscopy, and radiation detection require signal processing techniques. having a wide bandwidth (DC to 5 MHz).
