The optical fiber elements are typically individually coated with plastic layers and contained in a protective tube suitable for the environment where the cable is used. Design Optical fiber consists of a core and a cladding layer, selected for due to the difference in the refractive index between the two. In practical fibers, the cladding is usually coated with a protective layer. In September 2012, NTT Japan demonstrated a single fiber cable that was able to transfer 1 per second (10 bits/s) over a distance of 50 kilometers. Although larger cables are available, the highest speed.
