Overview

The label shall be permanently affixed, of sufficient durability to withstand the environment involved, and not handwritten. 4 (B) requires marking on switchboards, switchgear, and panelboards (supplied by a feeder) to indicate where the power originates, as well as its physical location. During the 2011 NEC ®. The latest edition of NFPA 70E (2021) does not specify “where” the label must go (nor have previous versions). It only indicates which type of equipment must receive a label and what must be on the label. Even with this guidance there are still many questions. This guide will give you practical steps to meet electrical panel labeling. Proper labeling of electrical panels and associated equipment is crucial for workplace safety, regulatory compliance, and effective facilities management, requiring careful consideration of standards, design, and installation practices.
